ROTARIANS HONORED

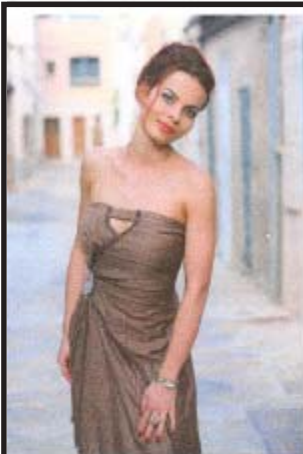
The Paradise Elks Lodge No. 2026 has recognized two of our Rotarians as Citizens of the Year.

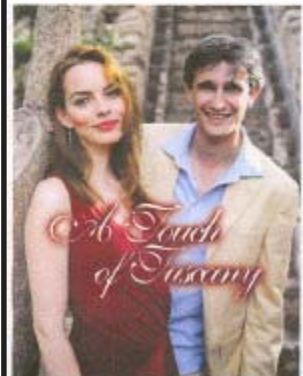
